



# Grand River Regatta 2019

**Grand River Sailing Club Regatta**  
**AUGUST 16 – 18, 2019**  
Fairport Harbor, Ohio

## **--NOTICE OF RACE--**

### **1. RULES**

- 1.1. The races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, US Sailing Prescriptions, the rules of the One Design Class (where applicable), and the sailing instructions.
- 1.2. In lieu of disqualification, alternative penalties as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions may apply. This changes RRS 44.1 and 64.
- 1.3. The regatta is classified as a Category C Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 1.4. RRS rule 60.1(a) is changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership.
- 1.5. RRS 61 is changed to include: "A boat intending to protest shall notify the RC Signal boat of her intention to protest and the class and sail number of the boat she is protesting, after clearing the finish line. She may do this via direct hail to the Signal Boat or by using the VHF radio channel assigned to her course."
- 1.6. US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 60.3, 63.2, and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.7. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail. This changes RRS rule 63.7
- 1.8. The Organizing Authority for this event is The Grand River Sailing Club

### **2. CLASSES**

- 2.1. The Regatta is open to all yachts in good standing with current PHRF certificates, members of one design class associations, and/or those assigned a rating in accordance with PHRF-LE Rule 7.8.
- 2.2. Yachts without current certificates will be assigned a Regatta rating at the discretion of the GRSC Race Committee applicable only at this event and without appeal in accordance with PHRF-LE Rule 7.8.
- 2.3. The GRSC Race Committee, at its sole discretion, whose decision is final and without appeal, shall determine eligibility and placement within divisions for PHRF, JAM, and One-Design classes.
- 2.4. One-design classes shall adhere to all applicable class rules.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1. All registrants shall submit a properly completed Application to Race form, measurement certificate, and applicable entry fee. Checks for registration fees should be made payable to **Grand River Sailing Club**.
- 3.2. Pre-registration **MUST BE RECEIVED** by 1800hrs Wednesday, August 14, 2019 for Spinnaker, JAM, and One-Design classes to avoid late registration fee.

3.3. Onsite registration will be accepted at the Grand River Marine Sailing Center between 1700hrs and 2000hrs on Friday, August 16, 2019.

#### **4. SCHEDULE**

4.1 Races are scheduled for PHRF, JAM, and any One-Design class of four boats or more.

4.2 Spinnaker, JAM, and One-Design classes are scheduled to race two races on Saturday, August 17, and one race on Sunday, August 18.

#### **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in at the registration desk.

#### **6. VENUE**

The courses will be held in the waters off Fairport Harbor, Ohio.

#### **7. SCORING**

7.1 The low point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will apply.

7.2 RRS Appendix A2 is changed. There will be no throw-out.

7.3 RRS Appendix A1 is changed to one race shall constitute a regatta.

#### **8. AWARDS**

8.1 Awards will be given separately for the Grand River Sailing Club Trophy Races and the Regatta series. A minimum of four registrants per class will be required to qualify for awards.

8.2 While all yachts may start with their respective classes, all scoring for the Grand River Sailing Club Trophy Races will be done utilizing PHRF handicaps.

8.3 Awards for the Regatta series will be presented to the top three finishers in each class. Awards for the regatta series and for the regatta overall will be presented on Sunday, August 18, 2019.

#### **9. DOCKAGE**

9.1 **Grand River Marine** is offering free dockage from Wednesday, August 14 through Wednesday, August 21 for pre-registered yachts. Rafting may be required. Boats taking dockage prior to August 14 or after August 21 will be billed \$0.90 per foot per day.

9.2 Yachts arriving prior to August 14 should call Paul Mathews at (440) 289-5262 for dock assignment.

#### **10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY AND INSURANCE**

10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority, Race, and Protest Committees will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10.2 Each participating boat shall show proof that it is insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000.00 per incident.
